



5 Things Calgary Homeowners Aren't Doing That Cost Thousands!

And how you can help prevent it DIY style!

Calgary's freeze-thaw cycles are brutal on concrete. Driveways, walkways, and front porches take a beating year after year—and most damage starts long before homeowners notice it. Here are the **five most common (and costly) mistakes** we see across the city.

1. Leaving Winter Chemicals on Concrete

Road salt, de-icers, and calcium chloride don't just disappear in spring. They soak into porous concrete, break down the surface, and cause **spalling**—where concrete flakes, pits, and crumbles.

2. Letting Water Penetrate Micro-Cracks

Concrete cracks aren't always visible. Water seeps into microscopic pores and hairline cracks, freezes, expands, and makes the damage worse every cycle. This is one of the biggest reasons driveways & paths fail years earlier than they should.

3. Ignoring Oil, Fertilizer, and Chemical Stains

Oil drips, lawn treatments, and cleaning chemicals don't just stain concrete—they weaken it. These substances penetrate deep, discolor the surface, and accelerate breakdown. Once they soak in, they're extremely difficult (and expensive) to fix.

4. Allowing Weeds and Moss to Take Hold

Vegetation in cracks and joints isn't just unsightly. Roots expand, lift slabs, and widen cracks, allowing even more water intrusion. What starts as a small weed can turn into uneven concrete and trip hazards.

5. Not Sealing Their Concrete at All

Unsealed concrete is like a sponge. It absorbs water, chemicals, oils, and dirt year-round. Over time, this leads to cracking, surface failure, and full replacement—often costing **thousands more** than preventative protection.

Calgary Homeowner Concrete DIY Checklist

Prevent Costly Repairs to Driveways, Walkways & Porches

Use this simple checklist each spring and fall to catch problems early and extend the life of your concrete—especially in Calgary’s freeze–thaw climate.

1. Remove Winter Chemicals

DIY Steps

- Rinse concrete thoroughly once temperatures stay above 0°C
- Scrub with a stiff broom or push brush
- Avoid acidic or harsh cleaners

Check if:

- White residue remains after rinsing
- Surface looks rough, flaky, or pitted

2. Stop Water From Entering Cracks

DIY Steps

- Inspect closely for hairline cracks and dark spots
- Fill visible cracks with a flexible concrete crack filler
- Ensure proper drainage away from slabs

Check if:

- Cracks widen after winter
- Water pools or darkens areas

3. Clean Oil & Chemical Spills Quickly

DIY Steps

- Absorb fresh oil with kitty litter or absorbent
- Use mild degreaser and rinse thoroughly
- Keep fertilizers and chemicals off concrete

Check if:

- Dark stains remain after cleaning
- Concrete feels slick or discoloured

4. Remove Weeds & Moss Early

DIY Steps

- Pull weeds as soon as they appear
- Use boiling water or vinegar (avoid salt)
- Clean out expansion joints annually

Check if:

- Roots are widening cracks
- Slabs appear uneven

5. Seal Your Concrete

DIY Steps

- Apply a basic concrete sealer every few years
- Follow cure times and weather guidelines
- Avoid thick, film-forming sealers

Check if:

- Water absorbs instead of beading
- Surface darkens when wet
